



NOTE: This document is intended to serve as a guide for transcribed credit articulation. The ultimate decision on acceptable licenses/certifications lies with the individual college and WTCS. Be aware that certification guidelines vary between technical colleges.

Wisconsin Administrative Code TCS 3.03 (9) (b) explains articulation certification as follows:

K-12 school districts may request certification from the board for secondary school instructors and shall pay the costs associated with processing such requests. Eligibility for certification granted under this paragraph shall be determined by the board based on consideration of factors including the secondary instructor's current certification by the department of public instruction; a determination that the high school course for which certification is sought is technical college introductory level occupational or occupational related; and a determination that enrollment in the course is limited to secondary students who have demonstrated a mastery of relevant prerequisite competencies. The certification eligibility factors shall be demonstrated in articulation agreements between the technical colleges and the secondary schools. Certification granted shall be for one academic year, or portion thereof, and may be renewed.

This document is intended to serve as a guide for transcribed credit articulation. Individual colleges may choose to insert courses and course numbers as applicable to their specific program areas.
