1. The Submission of Records section has been updated to include the July 15 deadline for Farm Training, Drivers Ed/Local Assistance, Fire Service 2%, and HazMat reporting student course data for payment purposes.

Description of Change

2. Message 628 has been updated to clarify the edits involving 8x *Program Fee Codes*.

October 2010 Changes

Description of Change

1. Message 907 concerning the S8 Post 911 Veterans has been modified to clarify the checking of *Program Fee Codes*. New messages 908-909 have been added as new edits for the S8 record that also check *Program Fee Codes*. New message 910 requires that the S8 record have a valid *Social Security Number* that matches the one on the S5 record.

September 2010 Changes

Description of Change

2. The new S9 Program/Certificate record has been created. There can be multiple S9 records reported for each student. For FY 2010-11 only Pathway Certificates and Embedded Technical Diplomas can be reported on this record. For FY 2011-12 reporting of all program enrollments will be moved to the S9 record from the S1. Error messages 924 thru 928 have been added to handle S9 record edits. These new messages may change and all

other messages dealing with program numbers will be affected in FY 2011-12.

Note that the data elements *Program Number*, *Program Graduate*, and *Technical Skill Attainment Assessment* on the new S9 record have different names than the corresponding old data elements on the S1 record because there is only one occurrence of each one.

4. A new data element (*Advanced an EFL Level*) with Y or N values has been added to the S7 record. Error Message 189 checks this data element, which can't be blank. This is needed for federal reporting. See the User's guide for determining how to code this element.
5. The data element *Completed ABE/ELL* has been renamed to *Completed ELL*. The renamed data element can only be used on records with an *ELL NRS Level* of 6. ABE completion will now be assumed if the student has a record with a *12.9 ABE Grade Level*. Error messages 170 and 171 are affected by this change.
6. Error messages 088, 089, 091 and 092 have been added to cover edits for the *Technical Skill Attainment-First Occupational Program* and *Technical Skill Attainment-Second Occupational Program* on the S1 record. These messages will be changed in FY 2011-12.
7. Error message 634 description has been clarified.
8. Warning message 930 has been added to indicate student will be considered LEP for reporting purposes.

August 2010 Changes

Description of Change

1. Warning message 638 has been modified to include grants with 112 appropriation as well as 146.

2. The 2010-11 version of the client reporting ISM was created. All changes made in the prior fiscal year are no longer flagged. New changes will be reflected in markup notation as they are made.
3. The use of Social Security Number as the primary file key has been eliminated. District Student ID is now used instead. Social Security Number is now entered only on the S5 record.
4. The Ethnic Category has been eliminated from the S5 record as a single data element. The use of previously optional fields for collecting multi-ethnic codes is now required.

July 2010 Changes

Description of Change

1. The table VALID PROGRAM FEE CODE AND AID CODE COMBINATIONS USED IN EDIT 640 has been updated to reflect the inclusion of *7x Aid Codes* as valid for most of the *Program Fee Codes* whose value is greater than 52.

April 2010 Changes

Description of Change

1. Message 537 has been changed from a warning to an error. This error flags course records for system-wide courses that have different credit values than the approved value. As always, errors must be resolved or supplied an accepted explanation before the client reporting file can be closed.
2. Additional clarification has been added to error message 634 concerning the definition of Program Fee Codes to explain their use and indicate which codes are compatible/incompatible with each other.

March 2010 Changes

Description of Change

1. New error messages 901 – 907 have been added for the new S8 Post- 911 record.
2. The optional *District Client Data* (12 bytes – positions 89 - 100) data element has been added to the end of the S7 Client Basic Education Testing Levels Record at district request. This field is not used or edited by the System Office, but will be recorded on the Client Reporting error record output and be available for downloading in the errors file. Districts will use this field to record testing location and/or instructor information to facilitate error resolution. It will not be captured in the Client Reporting master file.

February 2010 Changes

Description of Change

1. Edit 685 has been modified to compute the total eligible number of credits for a student in a basic skills course in a given semester. The error will occur if a student exceeds this total. This change will minimize the potential for over reporting of basic education credits.
2. The new Post 911 Veterans Benefits Record (S8) has been created to collect the amounts of federal Post 911 GI Bill benefits received by districts and the compensation payments made by districts to students whose benefits decreased as a result of converting to the Post 911 GI Bill program. There are a maximum of three S8 records per student per fiscal year. There are notes on anticipated edits at the bottom of the record layout. These edits will be finalized shortly.

January 2010 Changes

Description of Change

1. The information on *Scale Score* on the S7 record has been clarified to indicate it must be left blank if the Test Name is *Instructor Judgment*.
2. Warning message 013 has been added to indicate missing *Birth Date* may disqualify client for federal reporting.
3. Message 162 has been corrected to indicate the window of dates for a pre-test is 18 months (not 26 months).

November 2009 Changes

Description of Change

4. The time frame for allowable *Test Dates* on the new S7 record has been changed to more closely follow best testing practices. The date window for the first test date for a given test topic has been reduced.
5. Two new error messages 190 and 191 have been added to check for problems with the earliest test record date for a given *Test Topic* for a given client. There can not be multiple test dates before the start of the fiscal year and any test date before the start of the fiscal year must be after January 1 of the previous year.
6. The description of the *Scale Score* and error messages 174 and 175 have been modified to indicate that when the *Test Name* is Instructor Judgment (900), the *Scale Score* should be blank or zero.

September-October 2009 Changes

Description of Change

1. The new error message 161 has been deleted. This message pertained to the new S7

record. It prevented the use of summary and battery *Test Names* for the same *Test Topic* for the same person. It was determined that it is OK to use both summary and battery tests in the same testing series, so the edit was eliminated.

2. Districts have the option of submitting either Social Security Number or the District Student ID in position 9-17 on all Sx records in each student's record set. If the District Student ID is submitted in 9 – 17, then the *Social Security Number* must be submitted in positions 92 – 100 of the S5 record. **All districts must migrate to using District Student ID in position 9-17 by FY 2010-11.**
3. The edit 717 MULTIPLE WAT GRANTS FOUND was removed from the ISM. Multiple WAT grants are acceptable.
4. Edits 671 – 673 concerning the new Fire Service 2% reimbursement records were warnings but are now errors because the new reimbursement procedures are fully implemented.
5. For the Fire Service 2% reimbursement records were submitted under Program Fee Code 66 in FY 2008-09. Due to funding reimbursement processing changes, the program fee code for Fire Service has been changed to code 09 effective FY 2009-10. Program Fee Code 66 is eliminated and 09 is added. Error messages 671 and 672 were also affected.
6. Edit 667 was clarified to provide a location for the values for *Institution Transferring Credit* codes.
7. The section in the introduction that describes the **Important Reminders for District Reimbursements Based on Client Reporting Records** has been updated with more complete information.
8. As part of the redesign of the S7 record, old client messages 165 thru 173, 330, 432, 460 – 494, and 778 have been replaced with new messages 161 – 183. All information about the new S7 record has been updated in the Client ISM and the new FY 2009-10 is open for processing.
9. The S6 record intended to correct past year's files has been removed since it has not been used.
10. Client message 636 is being changed from a warning to an error. It will also be changed to check *Program Fee Code* (PFC) against *District of Residence* (it previously checked PFC against *Home Residence Code*).
11. The data element *Participant in Nontraditional Training and Employment Activity* – Position 28 on S2 record has been deleted. NTO activity is now identified with a specific grant. This change also led to the removal of error messages 122, 333 and 448.
12. For the data element *Service Provided Through Grant Activity Codes*, the title of code 15 has been changed from **Supportive Services** to **Disability Focused Supportive Services** to clarify the code function. The collection and reporting of this code has not changed.

13. References to ESL (English Second Language) has been changed to ELL (English Language Learner) throughout the document. This is a terminology change from Perkins.
14. The tables that control numeric conversion and editing validation for Client Reporting Course Grade (positions 57 – 58 on the S3 record) have been updated to reflect the needs for Perkins reporting. This change should be transparent for district Client reporting data submissions, but may affect results in the QRP system.

July 2009 Changes

Description of Change

1. The definition of the Highest Grade Completed has been clarified for the special cases of GED and HSED.
2. New one character Data Elements *Technical Skill Attainment-First Occupational Program* and *Technical Skill Attainment-Second Occupational Program* have been added to the S1 Client Demographic record in positions 78 and 79. The coding structure for both is as follows:
 - 1 = Passed assessment
 - 2 = Did not pass assessment
 - 9 = Not assessed

Note that districts will not be required to report specific codes in these 2 new fields unless the WTCS office has identified on the Program Master File an assessment basis that the districts are able to collect and report.

June 2009 Changes

Description of Change

1. Error messages 77 and 85 are bypassed for any associate degree (Aid Code 10) programs that were suspended prior to 06/30/2008. This is because that was the year the applied associate degree restructuring was implemented and suspended programs were not required to restructure.

May 2009 Changes

Description of Change

1. The entire layout of the S7 (Grants Testing Record) has been changed to reflect the new AEFL audit requirements. Under the old S7 record layout, there was one S7 record per student. There will now be multiple S7 records per student – one for each assessment test the student takes.

The new S7 record also has several new data elements (including *Test Date*, *Test Topic*, *Scale Score*, *ABE Grade Level*, *ELL NRS Level*, *Completed ABE/ELL* and *Test Name*) and

eliminates all the old testing level data elements. The data element dictionary is also being updated. The error messages associated with these client changes are currently under construction and will be published as soon as they are completed.

2. Changes have been made to allow courses to start in May for the summer semester. Error messages 505 and 585 have been updated to reflect this change.
3. All record layouts have been updated to indicate we are migrating to the use of the *District Student ID* instead of *Social Security Number* as the file key for data submission processing. This may take a couple years. As part of the work on this transition to using District Student ID instead of Social Security Number as part of our file key, the Social Security Number field has also been added to the end of the S5 record in positions 92 – 100.

Districts have the option of submitting either Social Security Number or the District Student ID in position 9-17 on all Sx records in each student's record set. If the District Student ID is submitted in 9 – 17, then the *Social Security Number* must be submitted in positions 92 – 100 of the S5 record. All districts must migrate to using District Student ID in position 9-17 by FY 2010-11.

March 2009 Changes

Description of Change

4. Error messages 340 and 362 have been clarified to flag programs that can not have graduates as part of the compatibility edit between program number and graduate code. Currently programs 10-800-x and 50-499-9 can not have graduates.

February 2009 Changes

Description of Change

5. Error message 512 wording has been modified to include any invalid *Course Number*. This message also includes any course that should not be reported in the client system.
6. Error message 438 has been eliminated. This message required that Perkin's Grant participants be classified as one of the special populations. Under the new Perkin's IV changes, this edit is obsolete.

September 2008 Changes

Description of Change

7. Error message 628 has been modified to exclude the Tuition Remission codes (0A, 0B, 0C, 0D and)E) in addition to 33,34,73 and 74.
8. The Client ISM for FY 2008-09 was created. The error message section was combined with the main Client Reporting ISM to create one document. When the Client ISM was originally created, the size of the document created a technical problem which is no longer

an issue.

December 2007 Changes

Description of Change

1. The reporting of *Ethnic Code* and multiple race/ethnic codes on the S5 record was clarified. Use of the multiple coding fields (positions 84-89) will be required starting in FY 2009-10 due to federal requirements.
2. A second location for the *Fire Department ID* was added to positions 29 – 33 on the S4 record. The *Fire Department ID* normally appears on the S3 record in positions 52-56. This alternate S4 location for the *Fire Department ID* was created at district request due to coding problems some districts have adding *Fire Department ID* data to the S3 record. Districts should consistently code the *Fire Department ID* on either the S3 or S4 record, but not both. If this *Fire Department ID* on the S4 is used, the State Office Grant Number should be coded 99999999y where y = the appropriate numeric year (i.e. 8 = 2008). Also in this special S4 situation, the entire rest of this S4 record starting with position 34 should be blank.
3. *Program Fee Code* 66 (Fire Service 2% Fee) was added for use with the new *Fire Department Code* data element and the automating of the fire training cost reimbursement process.
4. Messages 671, 672 and 673 have been added to verify correct usage of *Program Fee Code* 66 with the *Fire Department Code* and the list of fire training *Course Numbers*. These messages are all warnings for FY 2007-08, but will become hard errors in FY 2008-09. Reporting the fire service fee reimbursement data is optional in FY 2007-08 which is considered a pilot year. Data collected in 2007-08 will be used to test the new fire service training data collection and for data comparisons with the manual reimbursement process. Reporting the fire service fee reimbursement data is required in FY 2008-09. Starting in this year the fire service 2% reimbursement payments will be based on client data.
5. A *Program Fee Code* correction was made to error message 632.

November 2007 Changes

Description of Change

1. Error messages 77 and 85 require a curriculum be on file for a program. These edits will be bypassed for FY 07-08 suspended programs. The implementation of the AAS restructuring meant that these suspended curriculum did not roll over and resubmitting them under the new AAS structure is not practical.

Description of Change

1. The Fire Department ID has been added to positions 52-56 of the Client Course (S3) record. This field can only be entered on courses that are fire training courses. If the enrollment is not eligible for fire training reimbursement, leave this field blank. Use of this data element is optional for FY 2007-08 and required in FY 2008-09.
2. The table of PROGRAM FEE CODES AND THEIR VALID RECOGNIZED CREDIT CODES - USED IN EDIT 663 AND 669 has been modified to include 0E and a 9H for WIA (PFC 13).
3. For error messages 76 and 84 (graduated more than once from the same program), criminal justice program number 30-504-1 is bypassed.

September 2007 Changes

Description of Change

1. Warnings 566 and 568 concerning *Course Grade* have been changed to errors.
2. Edits 77 and 85 (no curriculum on file for program) are bypassed for program numbers 10-800-1, 20-800-1 and 20-800-2. 10-800-1 is a new program number called Collaborative Transfer Program. All courses on the system wide General Education course list are considered to comprise the curriculum for 10-800-1. The curriculum for Collegiate Transfer Programs 20-800-1 and 20-800-2 are considered to be all aid code 20 courses offered by the approved districts.
3. The explanation of error 632 was modified to reflect the fact that the 0A Program Fee Code is now 100% paid and can not be used with other fee codes. Program Fee code 0E is now available for use.

Errors 566 and 568 will be listed as warnings for the FY 06-07, but will be “hard errors” in all subsequent years. Warnings 567 and 569 are true warnings concerning invalid *Course Grade* in courses who’s *Aid Codes* do not require grade submissions.

4. The new data element *District-CBO Site* has been added to Client in positions 77-82 on the S4 record. This is an optional field added at district request and reserved for district use. Report the district site (e.g., CBO) where the grant activity took place. This field will not be edited by the System Office. December 2006 Changes

The decision has been reached at the System Office to retroactively change references in our Client Reporting System master files from the old nursing programs to their new numbers

We have had occurrences of districts submitting clients as graduates of both the old and the new *Program Numbers* (mostly the 30-level program), and of districts submitting both the old and the new *Program Numbers* on the same S1 record for FY 2005 and FY 2006. For this reason we have added edit number 103 as a warning to the 2006 client edits.

This warning will be flagged for all occurrences of any of the old 510 program numbers. The *Program Number* instructional area will be changed from 510 to 543 in each case. If you have coded both the old and the new program number, you will also see warning:

This situation is very similar to the nursing program number changes in item 2 above except it involves a different set of changing program numbers for the Computer Information Systems programs. Most of the time these will be outcomes (such as getting a GED) that were not identified until the fiscal year after the “real” grant had ended.

Dummy grant numbers must always have an invalid *Appropriation Number* and be for the current fiscal year. Use dummy *State Office Grant Numbers* only if there is no other way to capture the outcome.

A new warning 716 has been added to flag the use of dummy grant numbers. This change is effective for the FY 2004-05.
