

# Aid Code Definitions

## Postsecondary Courses and Credentials

### **Aid Code 20: AA/AS Associate Degree**

This aid code applies to those courses which are developed as part of the Associate in Arts or Associate in Science degrees designed for direct transfer to a four-year college or university. Aid code 20 includes programs and courses but no approved curricula.

### **Aid Code 10: Applied Associate Degree**

This aid code applies to those courses which are developed as part of the Associate of Applied Science or Associate of Applied Arts degrees or at the rigor of courses within associate degree programs. Aid Code 10 includes programs, courses and approved curricula.

### **Aid Code 30: Short-Term Technical Diploma**

This aid code applies to those courses which are part of a state approved program containing at least two (2) credits, but not to exceed twenty-five (25) credits. Aid Code 30 includes programs, courses and approved curricula.

### **Aid Code 31: One-Year Technical Diploma**

This aid code applies to those courses which are part of a state approved program containing at least twenty-six (26) credits, but not to exceed fifty-three (53) credits. Aid Code 31 includes programs, courses and approved curricula.

### **Aid Code 32: Two-Year Technical Diploma**

This aid code applies to those courses which are part of a state approved program containing at least fifty-four (54) credits, but not to exceed seventy (70) credits. Aid Code 32 includes programs, courses and approved curricula.

### **Aid Code 61: WTCS Pathway Certificate**

This aid code applies only to the State Board Recognized WTCS Pathway Certificate. Courses within the certificate bear the aid code of the already approved (parent) program. The certificate must contain at least two (2) credits, but not to exceed eighteen (18). Aid Code 61 includes programs and approved curricula.

### **Aid Code 50: Apprenticeship**

This aid code applies only to apprentice courses which are part of an approved program of apprentice related instruction and/or supplemental instruction restricted to apprentices and journeyworkers. Aid Code 50 includes programs, courses and approved curricula.

## **Aid Code 11: Advanced Technical Certificate**

This aid code applies only to the State Board Recognized WTCS Advanced Technical Certificate. The certificate must contain at least nine (9) credits, but not to exceed twenty-five (25). Aid Code 11 includes programs and approved curricula.

## **Continuing Education Courses**

### **Aid Code 42: General Adult: Non-Credit Development and Exploration**

This aid code applies to general adult educational offerings that contribute to basic education, citizenship and community safety for the general public.

Aid code 42 is also used for courses that provide career exploration and self-enrichment that is related to an occupation, but not directly related to employment. Aid Code 42 includes courses only.

Examples include: basic education, career exploration, camps and programs for independence (Learning for Independence, Occupational Aide Readiness (OAR), etc.)

### **Aid Code 47: Occupational Adult: Non-Credit Professional Development**

This aid code applies to educational offerings with a definite vocational/technical objective designed to either provide future employment or upgrade individuals in their present occupations.

Aid code 47 is used for courses which provide professional development directly applicable to a person's occupational goal. These courses are typically designed for individuals already on the path to the occupation, to up-skill individuals in their present occupations, or for development toward promotional opportunities. Aid Code 47 includes courses only.

Examples include: occupational training, exam preparation (not testing), conferences, workshops, pre-apprenticeship courses and Continuing Education Units (CEUs).

### **Aid Code 60: Community Services**

This aid code applies to educational offerings that are leisure-time, self-enrichment activities including arts, crafts, games, hobbies, sports, recreation and foreign language conversation. Aid Code 60 includes courses only.

## **Non-Postsecondary Courses**

### **Aid Code 73: Beginning Adult Education**

This aid code applies to Adult Education courses that cover competencies in grade levels 0 – 5.9. and is used with instructional areas 850 - 860, 862, and 890. Aid Code 73 includes courses only.

### **Aid Code 74: Intermediate Adult Education**

This aid code applies to Adult Education courses that cover competencies in grade levels 6 – 8.9 and is used with instructional areas 850 - 860, 862, and 890. Aid Code 73 includes courses only.

### **Aid Code 75: English Language Learning**

This aid code is used with area 861, applies to Adult Education courses in communicating in English for learners whose native or dominant language is not English. Aid Code 75 includes courses only.

### **Aid Code 76: Secondary Adult Education**

This aid code applies to Adult Education courses that cover competencies in grade levels 9.0 – 12.9 and is used with instructional areas 850 - 860, 862, and 890. Used with occupational instructional areas, applies to occupational courses taught to school-age youth seeking to complete high school diploma or HSED/GED requirements. Aid Code 76 includes courses only.

### **Aid Code 77: Developmental**

This aid code applies to instruction in secondary-school level academic subjects for individuals who need to strengthen foundational competencies to be admitted into a postsecondary program. Used with instructional areas 850 – 860. Aid Code 77 includes courses only.

### **Aid Code 78: Remedial**

This aid code applies to instruction in secondary-school level academic subjects for postsecondary program students. Used with instructional areas 850 – 860. Aid Code 78 includes courses only.
