


What is an Evaluation Plan?



A plan for collecting, analyzing, and using data to inform the continuous improvement of a quality, high-impact IET program.

The Importance of IET Evaluation Planning






Importance of IET Evaluation Planning



Early planning for IET evaluation is important for many reasons!

- Mitigates evaluation as an afterthought
- Establishes an expectation for data-informed decisions and continuous improvement
- Creates a roadmap for data collection, analysis, and reporting of results with partners
- Partnership return on investment
