Understanding a Single Set of Learning Objectives

What is a Single Set of Learning Objectives?

An IET program has a single set of learning objectives that identifies the specific:

- Adult education content
- Workforce preparation activities
- Workforce training competencies

Program activities are organized to function cooperatively



What is a Single Set of Learning Objectives?

Integrated Learning Objective:

1. Given a micrometer, a 6" scale, simple manufacturing specification blueprint with missing measurements, and a math worksheet, learners will apply knowledge of fractions and decimals to take and record precise measurements in decimals and fractions and use the measurements to answer fraction and decimal addition and subtraction questions with 80% accuracy.

Workforce Training Skills:

- Read a 6" scale
- Read a micrometer
- Read a simple blueprint

Adult Education/Literacy Skills:

- Convert measurements from inches to centimeters
- Convert whole numbers to fractions
- Add and subtract fractions

Workforce Preparation Skills:

- Apply mathematical operations, concepts, and reasoning
- Demonstrate quality consciousness
- Demonstrate self-management strategies
- Work within a team

Identify workforce training skills and competencies

Identify state adult education standards and academic literacy skills

STEP

Identify workforce preparation skills and competencies

Develop learning objectives for the SSLO and confirm alignment with goals

06

Build out contextualized units, lessons and activities
