HOW TO BECOME AN INSTRUCTOR FOR TRANSITION TO TRAINER

INSTRUCTOR AND ADMINISTRATIVE GUIDANCE (REVISED 2022)

INSTRUCTOR REQUIREMENTS

- 1. First, complete the WTCS 30-hour Teaching Methods course, or equivalent, approved by BAS.
- 2. Next, complete the Preparing to Teach Transition to Trainer (P2TT2T) six-hour course.
- 3. Once certified, maintain eligibility by teaching a T2T course at least once every three years.

INSTRUCTOR RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. Select instructional modality: in-person, online synchronous or asynchronous, or hybrid.
- 2. Populate course materials to a college learning management system or digital repository.
- 3. Provide learning materials to participants. Non-WTCS instructors must provide digital access to the materials.
- 4. Follow the approved curriculum.
- 5. Customize learning using digital resource library.
- 6. Email the completer roster to BAS@dwd.wisconsin.gov and mandy.johnson@wtcsystem.edu.
- 7. Third parties may provide administrative support.

WTCS & BAS RESPONSIBILITIES

WTCS

- 1. Manage scheduling, registration, and instruction for instructor training courses.
- 2. Issue course completion certificates for each required course to participants.

BAS

- 1. Issue the final "Transition to Trainer Instructor" certificate.
- 2. Maintain the master list of certified instructors.
