- This is the current list of WTCS systemwide general education courses. Due to institutional instructional decisions, not all colleges will offer all courses, but it is expected that a WTCS college will accept for transfer any systemwide general education course a student may have successfully completed at another college.
- **Courses listed in bold type are part of the current Universal Transfer Agreement (UCTA) with the UW System which, according to the agreement, will satisfy a general education or general degree requirement at the receiving UW or WTCS institution and may include elective credit. In addition, these courses may satisfy degree requirements differently depending on the course requirements related to the major that the student declares. Not all WTCS systemwide general education courses transfer equally to the UW System.**
- If transferability is a student's major goal, then verification of the transfer equivalency of each course prior to enrolling in the course is important. For up-to-date information on the transferability of a particular course to a UW System institution, please refer to the Transferology online credit transfer tool which is found on the Transfer Wisconsin website at <https://www.wisconsin.edu/transfer>. Additionally, these courses may be reviewed in the future for their continued inclusion on the WTCS list of systemwide courses.
- **Before registering for general education courses, students should talk to an advisor and consider their academic goals and intended major.**
- Students at the WTCS colleges: Chippewa Valley Technical College (AS degree); Gateway Technical College (AA/AS degree); Madison College (AA/AS degree); MATC-Milwaukee (AA/AS degree); Nicolet Area Technical College (AA/AS degree); Western Technical College (AS degree); and Northwood Tech (AA/AS degree) also have the option of selecting comparable courses at Aid Code 20 (the 200 level courses) in lieu of these aid code 10 systemwide general education courses.
