

Office of Instructional Services Summary of Educational Policy Updates and Educational Services Manual (ESM) Revisions



2024 WTCS Educational Policy Changes Office of Instructional Services

1) New ESM Chapter: Chapter 8 Working with Apprenticeships (January, February 2024)

Chapter 8 was released as a standalone document in January 2024 and published on myWTCS. Chapter 8 was then fully integrated into the ESM in February 2024.

2) Policy Change: New Program Development – Update to Equity Prompts (March 2024)

Equity prompt requirements for new program development were updated in 2024. See ESM Chapter 3 and ESM Form 3-1 Concept Review for complete guidance. Changes are as follows:

Item Q. on Form 3-1 requires colleges to respond to the following equity prompt: Describe your college's plan to promote systemic inclusion (removing barriers that prevent people from accessing what they need) and address equity gaps specifically for this new program. Incorporate plans to leverage Guided Career Pathways.

Item R. on Form 3-1 requires colleges to indicate the groups and individuals that were consulted or involved in establishing the equity plan described in response to Item Q.

In your response to the equity prompt, include the following information specifically related to this program:

- Program name and proposed number.
- A description of the equity gap(s) being addressed.
- A summary of the key activities.
- An overview of the intended outcomes.

When determining your activities, think about these areas:

- A. Advance Inclusive Excellence, Culture of Classroom
- B. Equity in Student Recruitment, Access, Retention & Completion, Student Outreach
- C. Equity in Recruitment/Hiring of Fac/Staff, Faculty Diversification
- D. Strategic Integration

Additional notes: Equity prompts were added in 2021 as a requirement for new program development. Implementation began in August 2021 with the addition of one equity prompt to the program approval process. June 2022 saw the addition of a second required prompt. ESM Release for March 2024 provided updated equity prompt guidance and Form 3-1 content.

3) New Policy Guidance: WTCS Course Requirements and Expectations (May 2024)

Guidance issued regarding the WTCS definition of a course, allowable courses, and exclusion of the following as courses: exams/practicals, orientations, tutoring, etc.

Revise General Studies terms for degree types to align with UCTA terms:

- Communications, Speech, and English = Communication
- Humanities = Humanities & Fine Arts
- Social Science = Social & Behavioral Sciences
- Natural Science = Natural Sciences
- Mathematics = Quantitative Reasoning



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Changes in both AA/AS degree requirements:

- Combine 6 credits English and 3 credits Speech to 9 credits Communication
- World/Foreign Language: Change 4 credit requirement to 1 course requirement in Global Language or Global Studies
- Diversity/Ethnic Studies: Change 3 credit requirement to 1 course requirement
- o Remove Health/Wellness 1 credit requirement

Changes only for AA degree requirements:

- Humanities & Social Sciences: Change from 24 to 21
- Natural Sciences & Quantitative reasoning: Change from 10 to 9 (no change in lab or level requirements)
- Electives: Change from 10 to "Up to 21" Changes only for AS degree requirements: o Humanities & Social Sciences: no change o Natural Sciences & Quantitative reasoning: Change from 20 to 18 (no change in lab or level requirements)
- Electives: Change from 12 to "Up to 21"

*Electives: The number of true electives a student may have will depend on local college requirements, partner institution requirements, and major requirements for desired pathway of study.

For the AA:

- Natural Sciences must include one lab course.
- Quantitative Reasoning must be at the course level of Intermediate Algebra, Quantitative Reasoning, Math for Elementary Teachers, or above.

For the AS:

- Natural Sciences must include two lab courses, one from each of the two different science disciplines.
- Quantitative Reasoning must be at the course level of College Algebra, Statistics, Quantitative Reasoning, or above.

*Electives: These credits are not necessarily meant to be "student choice" electives, but rather 21 credits locally determined by each college in a configuration best aligned with transfer, preferably at junior status, to a four-year university or college. A college may allocate these elective credits to additional requirements beyond the WTCS required minimum in any of the General Education categories and for any established pre-major pathway.

Note: Courses using Aid Codes 20 and 10 are allowed in the AA/AS degrees as outlined in the Educational Services Manual (ESM).
